

SYC DIVERS AT CAT HARBOR 2006



This year, there were nine divers at the Cat Harbor dive; what a great turnout for SYC! The divers were **Eric Peterson, Fred Johring, Tom and Debbie Lorenz, Steve Falberg and his brother Greg, Ted Carlsson and Paulie Jenkins, and Jack Smith.**

Due to swell, wind, and very poor visibility, the back side of Catalina was not diveable. The dive was made safely just inside Cat Harbor near the Head. Tom and Debbie Lorenz anchored Tommyrot just inside the Head. The rest of the divers tied their dinghies to the stern of Tommyrot.

The water clarity was still poor at 5-10 feet, but no wind, swell or surge to worry about. The water at a depth of 45 feet was still nice and warm at 61 degrees. In the many fish that paraded by we recognized Garibaldi, Sheephead, a ray, and many silversides such as anchovy, sardines, and smelt. Representing the invertebrates were many large sea stars.
